bicycle inner tubes	various	butyl	none	VeloPlus tube recycling program	Where available: Make use of the Schwalbe butyl tube recycling program. Schwalbe collects butyl tubes (all brands) and is able to make 100% new tubes out of it, at the same quality level of a tube made from <i>virgin</i> butyl. You can drop off tubes at your participating bicycle dealer. Where not available, either repurpose the tube or put it into your home garbage to be incinerated or landfilled.
coating for all bolts	Switzerland	blackened chrome	blackend for optical reasons	Switzerland	your local scrap metal service
rubber coating on hook	Germany	synthetic rubber	protects you bike from being scratched	France	If the rubber coating is worn it can be removed using a sharp knife, without leaving any traces on the aluminum. Then put it into your home garbage to be incinerated or landfilled. You can re-coat it by dipping the hook in liquid rubber yourself. Or consult the DAILY HOOK product manual for alternative, fully circular edge protection ideas. We did not go with these as a stock protective solution, since they were not economically feasible in serial production.
